Summary:

Responsibilities:

- Disassemble, repair and re-assemble engines according to OEM procedures.
- Identify parts using applicable manual references.
- Perform maintenance which includes QEC removal, installation and repair on engines owned by Willis Lease and Third-Party Customers. Under certified supervision.
- Perform engine disassembly on engines owned by Willis Lease and Third-Party Customers.
- Examine engine and components to determine the extent of any defects requiring repair or replacement of the part.
- Other duties as assigned.

Requirements:

- Must have High School Diploma or equivalent experience.
- Must be working towards receiving a FAA A&P License.
- Careful workmanship and attention to detail in performing duties.
- Ability to work under stressful conditions because of degree of responsibility required.
- Ability to read, understand and follow manual instructions in English.
- Ability to travel Domestic and International.

Physical Requirements

- Ability to lift or pull objects weighing as much as 70 pounds frequently.
- Agility to stand, lie, or kneel in awkward positions and to perform work from scaffolds or ladders.
- Manual dexterity required to operate tools to make adjustments and repairs.
- Sufficient visual acuity to inspect equipment for defects.
- Ability to work, at times, in small confined spaces.
